Term 2	<p><u>PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT - Mock Exam</u> Theme selected from previous exam paper Assessment Objectives One, Two, Three and Four</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Further development of ideas • Refine ideas and skills in a range of different media • Looking at the style and techniques used by other artists • Explore final ideas – compositions, maquettes and colour ways • <p><u>Mock Exam</u> Theme selected from previous exam paper Assessment Objective Four</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Final outcome produced during 12hour exam (3 x 4hour sessions)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluation and self-assessment of MOCK Exam work. • Revisit MOCK Exam coursework and complete any outstanding work based on assessment feedback. • Refinement of final piece based on assessment
Term 3	<p><u>Externally Set Task – GCSE Exam</u> Assessment Objectives One, Two and Three</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exam papers delivered and introduced to students • Initial ideas (Mind Map) • Exploring, researching and analysing the work of other artists that link to chosen theme. • Students will be supported in analysing the work of other artists. • Students explore creating their own work in the style of the artist/s that they have linked to their theme. • Record from direct observation – drawing and photography
