<p>Term 3</p>	<p><u>Externally Set Task – GCSE Exam</u></p> <p>Assessment Objectives One, Two and Three</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Exam papers delivered and introduced to students• Initial ideas (Mind Map)• Exploring, researching and analysing the work of other artists that link to chosen theme.• Students will be supported in analysing the work of other artists.• Students explore creating their own work in the style of the artist/s that they have linked to their theme.• Record from direct observation – drawing and photography
